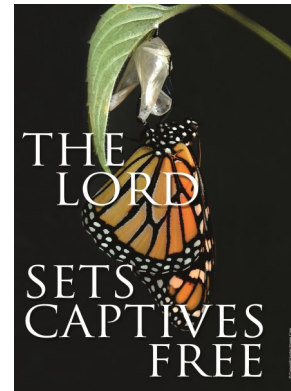

CARE FOR EACH OTHER

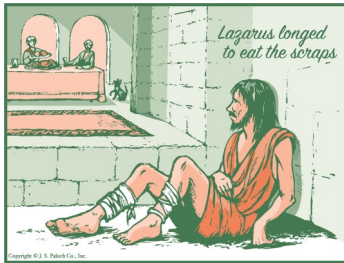

How has God shown mercy to me?

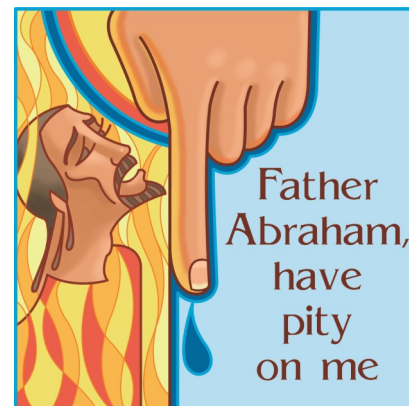
