FAQ

Our recent feasibility study has shown that many of you share the same questions about the future of St. Elizabeth Church. In this update, we'd like to address some of these questions and concerns:

What is Project Revive?

The name "Project Revive" was originally defined as an initiative to address serious maintenance issues with the historic church. This included falling roof tiles, decaying gutters and downspouts, clogged drainage system and water seepage/interior damage. The objective was to determine the needed repairs in order to maintain the historical significance of this beautiful church. However, this project has also been expanded to address the many needs of the Parish Center as well.

What is the Cost/Funding for this Campaign?

The parish council approved a goal of \$700,000 for this project based on the initial bid of \$622,944. The source of funding includes cash-on-hand, donations and pledges (over a three year period). The status of the parish finances is good. There is no debt, cash reserves are over \$135,000, and YTD income vs expenses is positive. The Diocese of Little Rock will loan the required funding based on an 80% commitment of pledges, donations and cash reserves.

What is the Timeline for this Campaign?

This campaign is currently engaged in various activities that will culminate with "Pledge Weekend" on May 3-4. Based on a successful campaign, we will then be able to engage in contracts. It is estimated that the construction phase will be completed in 12-16 months due to material lead times.

Parish Survey Results

Thank you to everyone who participated in the feasibility study! We received an incredible 77 responses—an outstanding level of engagement from our parish family of 98.

Below is a simplified summary of the survey results. For those who would like to review the full survey, including all comments, a detailed report is available for checkout at the Parish Center office.

For questions that asked you to rate on a scale, please note that 1 represents the lowest rating and 5 the highest."

- 1. How would you describe your level of involvement at St. Elizabeth? Avg Score 3.6
- 2. How would you respond to this statement "St. Elizabeth effectively meets my spiritual needs." Avg Score 4.5
- 3. What level would you agree with "St. Elizabeth is effective in providing opportunities for community and fellowship." Avg Score 3.8
- 4. What do you like most about St. Elizabeth? Father Joseph was mentioned in the majority of the responses, but you can read all of the comments in the detailed survey located in the office at the Parish Center.
- 5. In your opinion, please rate the importance of the following elements on how they meet your needs in your faith journey?

Homilies: 4.69 Spirituality: 4.10

Welcoming/Hospitality: 4.06

Music Liturgy: 3.95

Ministry Opportunities: 3.78

Faith Formation: 3.24

- 6. Today, before reading the Case Statement, how aware are you of "Project Revive"? Avg Score 3.80
- 7. I am confident that Fr. Joseph, parish staff, finance and parish councils, will make wise decisions regarding the future of St. Elizabeth. Avg Score 4.28
- 8. How important is it to you to be involved in a ministry at St. Elizabeth? Avg Score 4.29
- 9. What level of debt should St. Elizabeth Parish bear after the completion of "Project Revive"? \$250,000 or less.
- 10. What is your perceptive of the statement "The overall financial condition of St. Elizabeth is strong. Avg Score 3.46
- 11. How supportive are you, of a possible capital campaign to support "Project Revive"? Avg Score 4.42

12. There are many elements proposed as potential improvements/enhancements within the church and property. Please rate the importance of each of these items:

- 13. Are there any suggestions the parish might consider that would lead you to be more supportive of a possible capital campaign? You can review all of the responses in the detailed survey results located in the office at the Parish Center.
- 14. If St. Elizabeth conducted a campaign in the spring to support "Project Revive", how supportive do you anticipate the rest of the Parish will be? Avg Score 3.81
- 15. "It is urgent for St. Elizabeth to conduct a capital campaign now to address "Project Revive" issues?" Avg Score 4.44
- 16. If all of your questions were answered to your satisfaction, is this a campaign you would be willing to support financially at some level? 94% of the participants stated they would support it financially, the other 6% said they would like more information before they commit.
- 17. Do you foresee any obstacles or have any concerns that might prevent the Parish family from conducting a successful capital campaign? These comments are available in the detailed survey.
- 18. If you are encouraged to pledge 3% of your income to "Project Revive", how do you think this will be perceived by the Parish? Avg Score 3.64. How does this agree with you personally? Avg Score 3.72
- 19. If the campaign was held today, would you contribute, and if so, what amount would your family consider committing to? 21 families responded with a yes, and a total amount of more than \$335,000.
- 20. Would you consider working on a committee for "Project Revive"? 54 people said they would.
