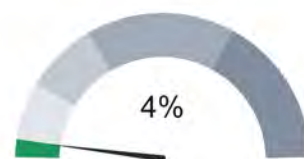

## DID YOU KNOW?

Historical records indicate that St. Elizabeth Church has undergone two significant roofing repair projects since its original construction in 1908. The first occurred in 1950 when 478 replacement tiles were ordered from the Ludowici Tile Co, as shown on this receipt. The most recent repair took place in 2013, when a local roofing contractor removed the tiles, installed new underlayment, and reinstalled the existing tiles.

While the 2013 project provided temporary relief from water issues, it was only partially successful and not a long-term solution. Now, after 117 years, our architect and multiple roofing experts strongly recommend a complete roofing system replacement—including all new tile, flashing, and guttering, to ensure the church remains protected for generations to come.

The majority of our existing tiles are original Ludowici Tiles, installed in 1908, making them 117 years old. Several parishioners have asked why we are not replacing the tile with a less expensive alternative. While the Board carefully considered this option, they ultimately decided to preserve as much of the original material as possible. This approach not only honors the church's historical integrity but also ensures that future generations inherit the same high-quality craftsmanship that has protected St. Elizabeth Church since its expansion to its current layout in 1908-1909.

## Meet Our Project Contractor

**The Durable Slate Company** was selected as our contractor after obtaining bids from 3 companies that specialize in historic building repair and roof replacement. Their offices are located throughout Ohio and Maryland and service the entire United States. Established in 1986, they specialize in premium historic roofing, including slate, copper, and clay tile, as well as copper gutters. They are also certified to install Ludowici terra cotta tile, our existing and replacement tile choice.

Due to their high standard of ethics and integrity, they have won numerous awards including the International Award for Marketplace Ethics from the Better Business Bureau, the 2019 North American Properties Award for Our Lady of Peace Chapel, on Xavier University, and frequent Super Service award's from Angie's List, given to the top 5% of companies who sustain a superior service rating each year.

They have worked on some of America's most prestigious architectural and prominent buildings, including Carnegie Library, Eureka Springs, AR; St. Andrew's Church in Roanoke, VA; Steeple Square in Dubuque, IA; St. Mary's Catholic Church in Conshohocken, PA; St. Mary's Cathedral in Grand Island, NE; Cathedral of Saint Helena in Helena, MT; St. Joseph's Church in New Orleans, LA; Frank Lloyd Wright's Westcott House in Springfield, OH; and many others.
